

Please see attached advice from QRIC regarding the steps required for Registration, Ear branding and Mark Up of new pups. Specifically for ear brand, microchipping and marking up please call QRIC on 1300 087 021 to make an appointment.



LITTER APPLICATION NOTICE – Important changes

The QRIC have enclosed:

- **Litter registration application form** – check all details, fill in any blanks & make sure it's signed.
- **Litter vaccination record** –
 - Proof of a minimum C3 Vaccination between the age of 6-8 weeks
 - Proof of a minimum C5 Vaccination between the age of 10 -16 weeks.Each pup must be identified on the form and this form **MUST** be returned with litter application.
- **Breeder's record sheet** – you keep this because you need to record name and address of person you have sold or given a pup to.
- **Microchip registration application/s** – **you must** fill in form/s completely and correctly – each form allows for registration of 4 greyhounds, sign each page and complete colour, sex, whelp date for each pup.

What you have to do?

- When your pups are 8/9 weeks old please call the QRIC Animal Welfare department on 1300 087 021, to make an appointment to have your pups, ear branded, marked up and micro chipped. The QRIC will not be able to arrange an appointment unless you have provided proof of the 6-8 week C3 vaccination.
- Ensure all paperwork is completed including the litter application and pet register forms.
- **Queensland law states that the pups must be micro chipped between the ages of 8 - 12 weeks of age. It is your responsibility to comply with the Animal Management (Cats and Dogs) Bill 2008, and the QRIC is making every effort to assist you.**

What will the QRIC provide at the appointment?

- The QRIC will earbrand each pup and draw the markings of each pup on the litter application form.
- Microchip each pup and record chip number on the microchip registration form/s that you have completed.

What you must have ready to submit to the QRIC staff member on the day of your appointment:

- A completed and signed litter application.
- A vaccination record sheet
- A receipt number for payment to CAA.
- 6-8 week C3 Vaccination Record
- 10-12 week C5 Vaccination Record (not compulsory to submit at your appointment)

What you must do after the appointment:

- Provide the QRIC with the 10-12 week C5 Vaccination within 16 weeks of whelping to ensure you are not charged additional fees.
